Design Manufacture and/or modification of mobile on-site equipment including: welding, generating, lighting machines, water pumps, pressure washers and ancillary plant to customer's specifications including refurbishment, service, repair and parts service support. Distributed to trading partners and customers in the UK and Worldwide.
